

CAMPER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION & GUIDELINES PRESBYTERY OF LAKE ERIE

The apostles gathered around Jesus and told him all that they had done and taught. He said to them, "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat (Mark 6:30-32).

INTRODUCTORY INFORMATION:

Camp ministry is an incredible opportunity for children and youth to explore and deepen Christian faith and relationships in a place apart from their usual patterns. Knowing the value of this experience, the Presbytery of Lake Erie has committed scholarship funds to help lower the barrier to camp attendance. Those funds are overseen and distributed by the Spiritual Formation Committee.

A maximum of one-third of the fee can be covered by scholarship funds, but the amount of each scholarship will depend on the total funds available each year and the number of applicants received. Applications are considered on a case-by-case basis.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Scholarship funds are available for children and youth through age 18 who are active in a congregation of the Presbytery of Lake Erie. This qualification can be verified by the pastor or clerk of session of the congregation on the application.

The Spiritual Formation Committee reserves the right to review the credentials and suitability of camp programs. If the committee feels that a particular site or program is not appropriate for receiving scholarship funds, they will work with a family to find a suitable camp program.
